




- The types of playground equipment shown in the selection matrix below are indicative only and final designs may vary.

Similarly, the type of equipment to be incorporated into the selected playground style will also be based on the trends indicated by the on-line feedback form .
- A Playground Concept Design will be guided by the feedback and presented to Council where further suggestions may be incorporated to guide the final playground design
- All playground equipment selections are subject to budgetary constraints. Whilst every effort has been made to provide example equipment in accordance with the allocated budget, all works remain subject to industry design, pricing and evaluation.

- Final landscape and playground designs will be circulated to all respondents following appointment of relevant suppliers.





