

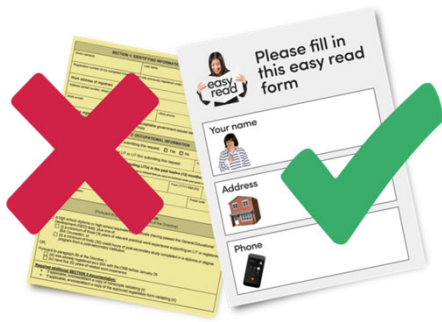

The City of Tea Tree Gully is a council that provides **local government** services for people who live north-east of Adelaide.

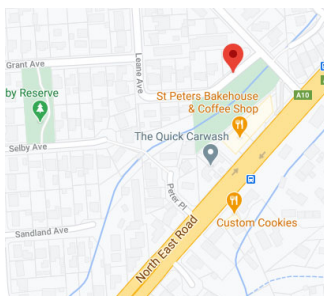


We are **upgrading** a local park called Ridgehaven **Reserve**.



Upgrade – is when improvements are made

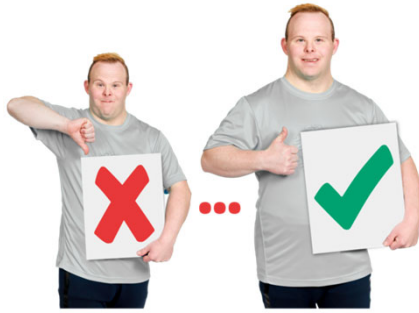
Reserve - is another word for park.

This could be climbing, spinning or flying equipment.

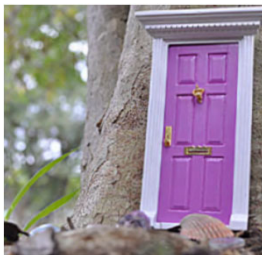


Or a **combination** of
